## Teacher/Occasional Teacher Tentative Central Agreement Town Hall Information Meetings:

On Monday, December 11, ETFO will be holding two town hall information meetings to review the terms of the Teacher/Occasional Teacher Tentative Central Agreement and answer members' questions. The first town hall meeting takes place from 6:30 pm to 7:30 pm EST. Grand Erie has been assigned the first call out time. If you are an OT with mulitple Locals, you can view the call that they have been assigned to if you are unable to attend the 6:30-7:30pm slot. Teacher and occasional teacher (T/OT) members will have an opportunity to listen in on one of these meetings.

Each local has been assigned a town hall time slot. The times are listed at the bottom of this CB eNewsletter, or you can see them <u>here</u>.

## Connecting to Your Town Hall Meeting: By Telephone

A few minutes before the start of your town hall meeting, you will receive a phone call from ETFO inviting you to join. The phone number that will call you to join the town hall is 416-800-9227. This phone call will go to the telephone number on file with ETFO's Member Records Department as of noon on Friday, December 8, 2023.

If you miss the call, ETFO will leave a voicemail message providing you with a callback number and a confidential PIN to join the meeting.

## Connecting to Your Town Hall Meeting: Online

At approximately 3:00 pm (EST) on Monday, December 11, members who have provided ETFO with their email address will receive a CB eNewsletter with a link (URL) to their allocated town hall meeting. This link will allow members to connect to their town hall online from a laptop or mobile device (cell phone, iPad, etc.).

This online link is being sent to ensure as many members as possible are able to

connect to the meeting if, for some reason, they do not receive a phone call inviting them to their town hall or are not able to connect by phone.

Because online connections tend to be more robust than telephone systems, ETFO strongly encourages as many members as possible to watch for the CB eNewsletter sent at approximately 3:00 pm on Monday, December 11 and use the information in that CB eNewsletter to connect to their town hall online (rather than by phone) a couple of minutes before the meeting starts.

## T/OT Tentative Central Agreement Ratification Vote -Monday, December 11 to Friday, December 15

At the conclusion of the telephone town hall meeting, the ratification vote for the 2022-2026 T/OT Tentative Central Agreement will begin. All members will be sent a link to the voting site by CB eNewsletter. The voting site link will also be available on the ETFO Collective Bargaining website. Voting will begin at approximately 9:00 p.m. (EST) on December 11 and will end at 8:00 p.m. (EST) on December 15. More information about the ratification process is available <u>here</u>.

While I know that reporting can be time consuming, it is important to complete the reports whether you are a Daily OT in an assignment or on an LTO. These reports are viewed monthly by the Joint Health and Safety Committee Workers and as a team we flag incidents and present them to

Management to ensure that all available resources are in place. These reports aid in addressing the need for ongoing EA support in classrooms as well as Social Work, Behaviour Councillors and any other resources such as PPE are available to the classroom in need.
