As you are aware, we have a new Collective Agreement. During Negotiations, we were able to create Report Card language for our OTs who are in LTOs around Report Card/Progress Reports. I am sharing this information with you as I have been receiving emails regarding report card writing responsibilities. Please see

the new language below.

ARTICLE 13.07

(a) Where a long-term assignment has no determined end date, and the regular Teacher returns from leave within a week of report cards or progress reports being completed, the Occasional Teacher may be requested to assist with the completion of these report cards or progress reports. In such instances, the Occasional Teacher shall be paid for the time to assist in the completing the report cards or progress reports. The rate of pay shall be LTO rate of pay for the day.

(b) Occasional Teachers whose LTO assignment ends prior to the assessment and evaluation PA Day shall leave all anecdotal notes comments and grades for the incoming Teacher in a format that is easy to understand for inputting into report cards in accordance with Growing Success.

It is extremely important that all OTs who are ending LTOs around report card time advocate for themselves. Please contact me if your Admin has requested that you complete reports and your LTO ends prior to June 3, 2024. Human Resources has confirmed that Admins are aware of the new language. I do not want you to be taken advantage of and if you feel that you are, please contact me ASAP.

I would also encourage you to complete an up to date [QECO Rating](#) if you have not already done so. Your QECO Rating will increase your grid placement when you are in an LTO. If you have no QECO Rating on file with the Board, you will be placed at "A" (starting at \$44,321) on the grid when most Elementary Teachers, once rated, are

actually placed at "A3" (starting at \$57,668). Your daily teaching experience is calculated in order to ensure that you are placed accurately on the grid. Even if you think that you will never accept an LTO and enjoy daily work, it is strongly recommended that you submit a QECO Rating to the Board as you could fall into an LTO at anytime. An LTO is an assignment of nine (9) consecutive days covering the same assignment.

If you are considering enrolling in an AQ Course or other personal professional learning, you can apply for up to \$450/year. You can find the information on our website (link at bottom of email) under Professional Learning and Forms.

getting support for students and recording incidents. When you completed your Mandatory Annual Health and Safety training, you completed a section on how to report an incident. While I know that reporting can be time consuming, it is important to complete the reports whether you are a Daily OT in an assignment or on an LTO. These reports are viewed monthly by the Joint Health and Safety Committee Workers and as a team we flag incidents and present them to Management to ensure that all available resources are in place. These reports aid in addressing the need for ongoing EA support in classrooms as well as Social Work, Behaviour Councillors and any other resources such as PPE are available to the classroom in need.
